ARRIVING & LEAVING

We kindly ask that you arrive and are picked-up at the class times shown on the timetable. This is to avoid a crossover.

Aged 11+

If aged 11+ you must wear a **face mask** entering and leaving the building (you may remove your face mask during the class itself/exercising/undertaking activity whereby it would negatively impact your ability to do so). Maghull Parish Hall

- A one-way flow system
- Parents/carers must not enter the building unless you are a new starter or if there are exceptional circumstances.
- **Arriving:** You must enter via the front main entrance situated opposite St. Andrews Church (unless requiring wheelchair access). Please remain outside by forming a queue socially distancing wherever possible. You will be called in one at a time (OTE will be cleaning in-between classes).
- **Leaving:** Students will exit via the back entrance (adjacent to St. Andrews Primary School). Where possible, during pick-up times, please maintain social distancing outdoors by **forming a queue**, when approaching the front of the queue, OTE will call out your child's name.
- Hand washing facilities will be provided at entry and exit points.



Haskayne Village Hall

- A one-way flow system
- Parents/carers **must not** enter the building unless you are a new starter or if there are exceptional circumstances.
- Arriving: Students must enter via the front main entrance maintaining social distancing.
- **Leaving:** Students will leave via the fire exit (adjacent to the car park).
- Hand washing facilities will be provided at entry and exit points.



ACCIDENTS, EMERGENCIES & ASSISTANCE

In an emergency we do not have to stay appropriately distanced if it would be unsafe.

If assistance is required e.g. first aid attention, OTE will be wearing PPE and will pay particular attention to sanitation measures such as hand washing immediately afterwards.



IMPORTANT CLASS UPDATES

All Classes

- There will be no access to communal areas such as the kitchen. If you normally use our glass/cups to have a drink of water, this will no longer be permitted. You must bring a bottle of **water** to class.
- If you, or anyone you know have felt unwell or have symptoms of COVID-19, do NOT come to class.
- Be ready to start. Be hydrated, nourished, and already have gone to the bathroom. The less area that is occupied, the less risk. If the bathroom must be used, a reminder to wash or sanitise hands before going into the stall and then wash hands after using the facilities.

Cheerleading & Acro Classes

• Under the current measures we will not be using **shared equipment**. This includes temporarily not using our blue mats. If you have your own mat at home (must not exceed 2m x 2m) we ask for you to bring this to weekly classes. If you do not have your own mat, we will supply individual mats that will be washed after each use, however, we strongly encourage you if it is within your means to purchase one.

 Please bring jazz shoes, ballet shoes and trainers. Where possible we will limit dancing with foot-thongs or bare-feet.
